O. Discussion, consideration, and possible action on The purchase of an asphalt roller. With the manual labor of the city crew at risk, this would reduce the possibility of injuries due to physically placing asphalt. It would also allow a decrease in time for the employees, saving money that is presently used for asphalt laying. As these can be purchased for approximately \$5,000, the maintenance supervisor be given full authority to purchase this item upon receipt of the refund from the worker compensation refund. The budget amount of purchase to be limited to \$7,000.

P. Discussion, consideration, and possible action to further benefit to the city improvements and reduce the risk of injuries, if sufficient money remains after the purchase of items 1, 2, and 3 funds, a bobcat skidder to be purchased. The maintenance supervisor to have permission to purchase this item at the time of receipt of the worker compensation refund.

Q. Discussion, consideration, and possible action for any remaining refund funds after the purchase of any or all of the approved above items to be placed in an ongoing "safety reward program" as a tool to promote workplace safety and health. Should all of the above items not be approved, all of the refund money to be earmarked for the specific use of safety items or programs. This money previously spent on the worker compensation premiums were for the specific purpose of the ongoing health and compensation for injuries sustained by failures of safety and/or injuries incurred by the City of Hartshorne employees. Although the refund is not mandated to be spent in any certain manner, the use of the money could well be used for safety measures to further prevent health and/or injuries to the employees.
