Financial Report: March 462,000 PWA PWA and General restricted by name on accounts 1.35 million end of March total 1.8 million we started with 1.6 mill. Grants are the major part driving the uptick. Sales tax is above budget all year. Royalty uptick 56,000 9 months in. Overall operating is higher than predicted at 153,000, expenses are lower by 50,000.

The mayor asked when we will amend the budget. Tracey replies June. IRS Taxes are estimated at us owing 300,000, without interest or penalty, recommends loan for that with a payout of 5 years. The years were 2018-2022. Years 23-25 are up to date. Yearly auditors are working on 2022 and will be at the May meeting. City sales tax income is up 12%
