

RESOLUTION NO. 01312022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF AN ELECTION IN THE CITY OF HARTSHORNE, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE REGISTERED QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF APPROVAL OR REJECTION OF A ONE HALF OF ONE PERCENT (0.50%) EXCISE TAX (IN ADDITION TO ANY AND ALL OTHER EXCISE TAXES NOW IN FORCE)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hartshorne, Oklahoma (the “City”) has determined to submit to the registered qualified electors of the City the question of approval or rejection of an Ordinance of the City relating to the levy and collection of an additional one half of one percent (0.50%) excise tax; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to place on the ballot this proposal for the election on April 5, 2022 for the purpose of submitting the hereinafter referenced proposition to the registered qualified voters of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARTSHORNE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City be, and he is hereby authorized to request the placement of this proposal on the ballot for the election to be held in said City on the 5th day of April, 2022, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters thereof the following proposition:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall the City of Hartshorne, Oklahoma be authorized to levy and collect an additional one half of one percent (0.50%) excise tax (sales tax), in addition to any and all other excise taxes now in force, with the proceeds thereof being used to fund water system improvements and associated costs, and with said revenues also being available to pay debt service on obligations issued by the City and any public trust having the City as the beneficiary thereof to finance or refinance said water system improvements and associated costs?




